### ***Reporting concerns***

If you have a concern about an individual's physical, sexual or emotional wellbeing, it is your responsibility to seek advice and support from your Parish Safeguarding Officer (PSO) or Diocesan Safeguarding Advisor (DSA).

Any safeguarding concerns or allegation must be immediately reported to the PSO or DSA.

Any safeguarding concerns or allegations about anyone in a Parish role must be immediately reported to the DSA.

- If you think there is an immediate risk of harm call the Police on 999
- If it isn't an emergency but you need help fast call the Police on 101
