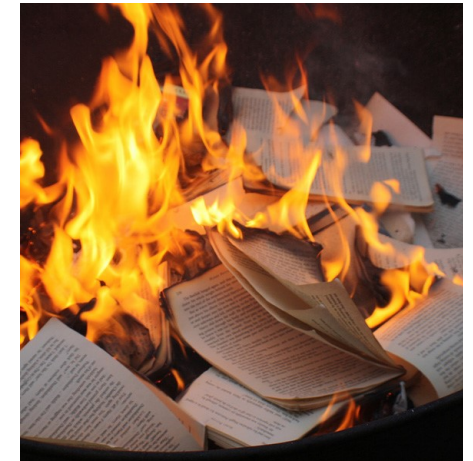
The family of Doris Haynes as we prepare for her funeral at 2.30 pm on Tuesday Feb 15th.
